On Wednesday, the 13th of March we will have **Lenten Reflections at 7pm** and this will continue each **Wednesday** of Lent.

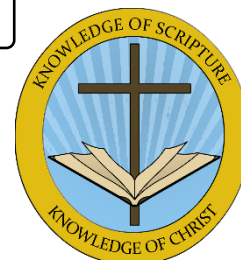
The Stations of the Cross will be held every Friday evening followed by Mass during Lent, until the solemn VIA CRUCIS around the church on Good Friday morning.

FIRST READING*Deuteronomy 26:4-10*

Moses said to the people: 'The priest shall take the panner from your hand and lay it before the altar of the Lord your God. Then, in the sight of the Lord your God, you must make this pronouncement:

"My father was a wandering Aramaean. He went down into Egypt to find refuge there, few in numbers; but there he became a nation, great, mighty and strong. The Egyptians ill-treated us, they gave us no peace and inflicted harsh slavery on us. But we called on the Lord, the God of our fathers. The Lord heard our voice and saw our misery, our toil and our oppression; and the Lord brought us out of Egypt with mighty hand and outstretched arm, with great terror, and with signs and wonders.
