Father's Message

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. It is the very 'Source and Summit' of our Christian Life. Jesus makes crystal clear "As I, who am sent by the living Father, myself draw life from the Father, so whoever eats me will draw life from me." In him there is fullness of life. Sacramental Communion, which our people have missed so painfully for many weeks until recently, made us keenly aware of the treasure Jesus gave us.

St. John Paul II writes "Through our communion in his body and blood, Christ also grants us his Spirit. Saint Ephrem writes: "He called the bread his living body and he filled it with himself and his Spirit... He, who eats it with faith, eats Fire and Spirit." (Ecclesia de Eucharistia 17) The Church implores this divine Gift, the source of every other gift, in the Eucharistic epiclesis.

What we receive in Holy Communion, the Holy Spirit, depends on what God wants to give us, and on our disposition to receive it. The more personal is my relationship with Jesus whose body I eat, the more abundant the unlocking of the gifts of the Holy Spirit in me.

"O precious and wonderful banquet that brings us salvation and contains all sweetness! Could anything be of more intrinsic value? Under the old law it was the flesh of calves and goats that was offered, but here Christ himself, the true God, is set before us as our food. What could be more wonderful than this? No other sacrament has greater healing power; through it sins are purged away, virtues are increased, and the soul is enriched with an abundance of every spiritual gift. It is offered in the Church for the living and the dead, so that what was instituted for the salvation of all may be for the benefit of all. Yet, in the end, no one can fully express the sweetness of this sacrament, in which spiritual delight is tasted at its very source, and in which we renew the memory of that surpassing love for us which Christ revealed in his passion." (Divine Office of Corpus Christi)

Prayer focus: Holy Communion is our most ordinary way to receive the Holy Spirit.
