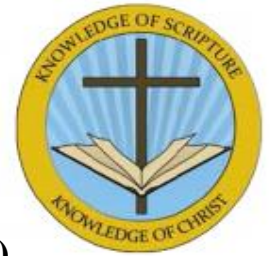

## Parish Religious Education Programme (PREP) DUTY OF CARE

The St. Jerome's Catholic Community has a Duty of Care to the children attending the Parish Religious Education Programme on Parish premises during the school term. The children's safety and well-being are of utmost importance, and we seek your support and cooperation in upholding our conditions of participation.

We, therefore, advise you to read through and give consent to these conditions before you enrol your child for the Sacraments

1.	<i>Classes for First Reconciliation and Holy Communion and Pre-confirmation on Tuesdays at 3.45pm – 4.45pm</i>
2.	<i>Classes for the Sacrament of Confirmation on Saturdays at 7.45am to 8.45 am followed by Mass</i>
3.	<i>Children are Supervised only five minutes before and after the classes.</i>
4.	<i>It is the responsibility of the parents to sign them in and out when they bring the children in and pick them up.</i>
5.	<i>Please drop off the children into the classroom and pick them up from the classroom</i>
6.	<i>An older sibling of the child attending PREP classes do not suffice as adequate supervision or validate signing in or out of the class (unless over 18 years old)</i>
7.	<i>Signing in and out sheet is used to check child's attendance. If your child miss classes for 3 consecutive weeks with no prior notification, their enrolment will be withdrawn, and the reception of the Sacraments will be jeopardised. Over all 75% attendance is required to receive the Sacraments.</i>
8.	<i>Please nominate authorised person, who drop off and pick your child up on the enrolment form. Catechists are not permitted to release your child to any unauthorised person.</i>
9.	<i>Please contact the Catechist Coordinator <b>Soly Fernandez on 0423168764</b>, if your child(ren) is unable to attend the classes.</i>

Our Catechists are well trained volunteers from our parish, who dedicate their precious time in assisting you to help your children to better know God's love and the teachings of the Church through our Parish Religious Education Programme.
