## GOSPEL ACCLAMATION: John 10:14

**GOSPEL:** John 10:11-18

Jesus said:

'I am the good shepherd:

the good shepherd is one who lays down his life for his sheep.

The hired man, since he is not the shepherd and the sheep do not belong to him,

# Father's message **GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY.**

"I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd is one who lays down his life for his sheep." (John 10:11) Jesus repeats four times, in this passage, that he lays down his life for our sake, to give us life, to protect us from evil, from the evil one. We are in Eastertide: we know how much Jesus loves us. Life, freedom, and joy are available to me, no matter what.

"I am the good shepherd; I know my own and my own know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I lay down my life for my sheep." (John 10:14.15)

It is warmly encouraging to hear Jesus saying that he knows his own. He knows me by my name, he laid down his life for me. I am the Beloved, redeemed, paid for with the blood of Jesus. I also learn that my freedom is respected, even at the risk of losing me: "my own know me". If I am Jesus' own, I know him. I do not know of him: I know him. If I do not know Jesus personally, probably I am not yet his own. I need to want to be Jesus' own, and take steps to know him personally. I do not want to know Jesus in a functional, perfunctory way. I want to know Jesus personally. I want to be his own, known by him, carried like a lamb on his shoulders.

I want to be Jesus' own. I want to know him personally. Commit to knowing Jesus personally, in your daily life - not just at "being religious".

#### **GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY: WHAT IS IT?**

Because [today's] Gospel reading is the parable of the Good Shepherd, the Fourth Sunday of Easter is now also known as Good Shepherd Sunday (a name formerly given to the Third Sunday of Easter to which the reading was originally assigned). In 1964, Pope Paul VI established a World Day of Prayer for Vocations to coincide with Good Shepherd Sunday, now celebrated on the Fourth Sunday of Easter. For this reason, this day is also known in the Catholic Church as Vocations Sunday. The Church of England also celebrates Vocations Sunday on this day. (source: Wikipedia)

"Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you; before you came to birth, I consecrated you" (Jeremiah 1:5).
