Father's message **HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY**

May they all be one!

The Holy Trinity is something that we will never be able to properly explain. It escapes our ability to understand completely: three distinct persons are one God.

Jesus enabled us to have a glimpse in his relationship with the Father and the Holy Spirit. He spoke about them. His disciples witnessed moments of his relationship. He spoke about them and often stressed the fact that they were one and were working as one.

We have a glimpse of the beauty of the Trinity when we see a family where people who are very different can get along, appreciate and love one another.

The same is true of a wider group or community like ours. At times it is almost a miracle that people so different in culture, languages, inclinations, personality, can really appreciate and love one another, live, and work together because of our common love for Jesus and his kingdom.

Jesus prayed that we may be one, even as we are so different.

"I pray [...] that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me. I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one—I in them and you in me—so that they may be brought to complete unity. Then the world will know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me." (John 17:20-23)

Jesus is aware that our unity in diversity is what may cause the world to believe.

Our community has grown a lot in this regard.

The Holy Trinity can be experienced through us.

May they all be one - so that the world may believe.

We can provide an experience of the Holy Trinity through our unity in diversity. What step can I personally take today, before I go home, towards greater unity?

THE HUMAN FAMILY IS AN IMAGE OF THE TRINITY

The Catechism of the Catholic Church gives us an analogy wherein we can see the reasonableness of the Trinity by helping us to see the possibility of distinct persons who possess the same nature. CCC 2205 provides:

"The Christian family is a communion of persons, a sign and image of the communion of the Father and the Son in the Holy Spirit." When we think of a family, we can see how a father, mother, and child can be distinct persons and yet possess the same nature (human), just as the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are three distinct persons who each possess the same nature (divine).

The weakness, of course, is that in God each person possesses the one infinite and immutable divine nature, and is therefore, one being. Our analogous family consists of three beings. No analogy is perfect. taken from: https://www.catholic.com/magazine/online-edition/explaining-the-trinity


