Can't you see that you have used two different standards in your mind, and turned yourselves into judges, and corrupt judges at that? Listen, my dear brothers: it was those who are poor according to the world that God chose, to be rich in faith and to be the heirs to the kingdom which He promised to those who love Him. The Word of the Lord. R. Thanks be to God **GOSPEL ACCLAMATION :** Mt 4: 23 Alleluia, Alleluia! Jesus preached the Good News of the Kingdom and healed all who were sick. Alleluia! **GOSPEL:** Mark 7:31-37 Returning from the district of Tyre, Jesus went by way of Sidon towards the Sea of Galilee, right through the Decapolis region. And they brought Him a deaf man who had an impediment in his speech; and they asked Him to lay His hand on him. He took him aside in private, away from the crowd, put His fingers into the man's ears and touched his tongue with spittle. Then looking up to heaven He sighed; and He said to him,

'Ephphatha', that is, 'Be opened.' And his ears were opened, and the ligament of his tongue was loosened, and he spoke clearly. And Jesus ordered them to tell no one about it, but the more He insisted, the more widely they published it. Their admiration was unbounded, 'He has done all things well,' they said, 'He makes the deaf hear and the dumb speak.'

MESSAGE: Messianic Encounter: "He took him aside in private" (Mk 7:33)

Do we listen? Are our ears open? Do we speak the word of the Lord? These are the questions that can be seen in the readings today. We are invited to have our ears opened and to learn to speak God's own words.

'Ephphatha' (Mark 7:34) (Jesus)

The deaf and dumb man was brought by others who knew Jesus. There must be someone who brings you to Jesus. That is why we invite people to church, to Mass, to Rosary, Youth group, other devotions, to the men's group, etc.

Jesus pulled the man aside from the crowd. He wants a one-on-one relationship, individually. That is where we are changed. That is where we can see, hear, speak, walk. One on one with Jesus - after our friends helped us to get there.

"Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened and the ears of the deaf unstopped; then the lame shall leap like a deer, and the tongue of the speechless sing for joy. For waters shall break forth in the wilderness, and streams in the desert; the burning sand shall become a pool, and the thirsty ground springs of water". Is 35 5-7

'Ephphatha' (Mark 7:34) (Baptism)

This sign is used at baptism because it makes visible the ability of a disciple to hear and share the Good News. Disciples can see what others cannot see, even when it is right in their face.

We need our ears to be opened and our tongue loosened and help others in the same way.
