Father's Message

The word Advent — it's a Latin word, "advenio" — means "the coming." Not "he came" but "the coming." There are really three Comings of the Lord and each one in its own way is very important for us to understand.

The First Coming, of course, is the coming of the child, the coming of the Saviour, the coming of Emmanuel, God with us, and he comes in Bethlehem, and this is an historical coming.

The First Coming is God comes in weakness, God comes in the quiet of the night, God comes like a helpless child, in need of men and women to take care of him, to watch over him, to feed him, to do all these unbelievable things when you think that the Blessed Mother and Joseph are raising a child who is God Himself.

The Second Coming is more dramatic. The Second Coming is the end of the world, as described in the Gospel (Luke 21:25-28, 34-36) The Second Coming, when will it come? No one knows. Jesus says, "Only the Father knows" (Mt 24:36). Jesus reminds us of our readiness to welcome him; "When these things begin to take place, stand erect, hold your heads high, because your liberation is near at hand." (Luke 21:28)

The Third Coming is that Jesus is with us. The Risen Lord will be with us on the journey, down through the years, no matter how long it takes, will be at our side, never abandon us. And, of course, this is the real joy of Advent: the knowing of, and the loving of, this Messiah who comes to lead us safely home.

Our waiting for Jesus is a moment of joy and expectation and not a tension-filled situation. Therefore, here in the season of Advent let us live by faith, walk in hope, and are renewed in love so that when Jesus comes at the end time to be our judge, we shall not merely know him, but come to him as a friend.

Thus, Jesus gives us the warning: "Stay awake, praying at all times." (Luke 21:36). He does not want us to be caught unawares.

ADVENT

Advent has a twofold character, for it is a time of preparation for the Solemnities of Christmas, in which the First Coming of the Son of God to humanity is remembered, and likewise a time when, by remembrance of this, minds and hearts are led to look forward to Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. For these two reasons, Advent is a period of devout and expectant delight. Advent begins with First Vespers (Evening Prayer I) of the Sunday that falls on or closest to 30 November and it ends before First Vespers (Evening Prayer I) of Christmas. The Sundays of this time of year are named the First, Second, Third, and Fourth Sundays of Advent. The weekdays from 17 December up to and including 24 December are ordered in a more direct way to preparing for the Nativity of the Lord. (The Roman Missal)
