Father's Message

The end of times. Today's Gospel leans heavily on Apocryphal language.

Mark depicts the final end as a grand cosmic short-circuiting. The cosmic signs will be visible, such as the failing of light from the sun and the falling of the stars from the sky. The entire fold of heavenly powers will be shaken. The Son of Man will be vindicated and God's people, wherever they are, will be gathered once again.

A topic that stirs the passion of many of our contemporaries, including many in our Catholic folk. Reading the signs, predicting the end - that's the idea.

Pity the Lord told us it is a waste of time:

'But as for that day or hour, nobody knows it, neither the angels of heaven, nor the Son; no one but the Father.' (Mark 13:32)

So why did he mention the very idea of signs, if we cannot predict the coming of the end of times? Because he wants us to be ready for *Him*, all the time, not just for the end of times. Our focus is on Him, not on the end.

"So, with you when you see these things happening: know that he is near, at the very gates." (Mark 13-29) "He" is "the Son of Man" (Mark 13:26)

My focus is to be ready to encounter Jesus, any time. No worries about the end. The time is now, the place is here. If I am ready in the present, I will be ready all the time.

NOVEMBER - MONTH OF PRAYER FOR THE DECEASED FAITHFUL - INDULGENCE EXPLAINED

The month of November is dedicated to the Holy Souls in Purgatory. The Church commemorates all her faithful children who have departed from this life. The Church has always taught us to pray for those who have gone into eternity. Please do ask for the Mass to be offered for your dear ones who have passed from this life, and do not let concerns of offerings hold you back. Do let us know. One can gain a plenary indulgence visiting a cemetery each day between November 1 and November 8, along with prayer, sacramental confession and communion within 2 weeks. These indulgences are applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory.

A plenary indulgence, again applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is also granted when the faithful piously visit a church or a public oratory on November 2. In visiting the church or oratory, it is required, that one Our Father and the Creed be recited.

A partial indulgence, applicable only to the souls in purgatory, can be obtained when the Eternal Rest (Requiem aeternam) is prayed. This is a good prayer to recite especially during the month of November:

Eternal rest grant to them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen

Special Month to prayer for the souls

During the month of November, we pray in a special way for our deceased relatives and friends. Please bring your "List of Souls" for the offering of Holy Masses for the Souls in Purgatory and place it in the box provided.

We confirm the procedure which will be followed:

For every "List of Souls" a Holy Mass will be offered.

To cope with this task - given the sizable number of envelopes that are usually submitted- we will resort to the help of our Somascan confreres in other countries. By email we will inform them of the Mass Intentions to be offered, possibly on a daily basis.

The daily Mass intentions to appear in the Bulletin will refer to the case of death anniversaries or Special Intentions for living persons and we request that no more than two names per intention (per Mass) is listed
