#### **FATHER'S MESSAGE**

On the Fifth Sunday of Ordinary time year C we reflected that Jesus asked Simon to "put out into deep water and pay out your nets for a catch" and chose his first disciples.

Jesus wants to transform them to become Apostles saying:

"Do not be afraid; from now on it is men you will catch"

Then he started to train them with his new teaching from the "Sermon on the Plains"

Today's gospel from St Luke follows immediately upon his beautiful explanation of unconditional love whereby we are to love even our enemies. Jesus teaches us that the quality of our heart determines the quality of our words and actions. He says: "A good man draws what is good from the store of goodness in his heart; a bad man draws what is bad from the store of badness. For a man's words flow out of what fills his heart" (Lk6:45)

The Letter of St James gives crystal clear indications on usage of the tongue.

Secondly, Jesus poses the question before us "Can one blind man guide another? Surely both will fall into the pit" (LK 6:39)

But seriously, think of this: could you show someone the way to Heaven? If you could not, how do you know you are on the right path?

Well, we are coming up to Lent. It is just a few days away now. In Lent we are called to death and in Easter to resurrection. What are you doing? If you are merely giving up something, why are you giving it up?

It is important that we give up something that will correct our hearts. We usually work with the three areas – prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Look at what your heart does when it is weak. What does it say, or do, or think and use this Lent to correct it.


