Father's Message Baptism brings renewal

Jesus, indeed, did not need baptism: he is without sin, he is the one who is holy and pure by Essence, being the very Son of God.

"He will baptise you with the Holy Spirit and with fire."

Whenever and wherever the Holy Spirit take the centre stage there is newness and people who are anointed with the Holy Spirit become very much active in spreading the Gospel or Evangelisation

The angel said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be holy; he will be called Son of God" Lk 1:35.

When Mary accepted the message from an angel the work of redemption begins to take place.

When Elizabeth was greeted by Mary "... the child leaped in her womb. And Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit" Lk 1:41.

After the birth of John, he became the herald of the Messiah.

"...and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove." Lk 3:22

After the baptism by John, Jesus began his public ministry from Galilee.

At the Pentecost event the apostles were transformed. The timid, lukewarm, and terrified apostles became courageous and passionate in spreading the Gospel. "All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability." Acts 2:4

The most ancient prayer to the Holy Spirit that we often pray remind us of the renewal and regeneration. Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, and enkindle in us the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and we shall be created, and you shall renew the face of the earth. Amen.
