FATHER'S MESSAGE

God Surprises us

A woman caught in adultery, the law of Moses saying that she should be stoned, the leaders of the Jewish people using her as an opportunity to attack Jesus, those who judge others, and Jesus, the Fountain of Divine Mercy,

Jesus places a bigger challenge before the accusers. *"If there is one of you who has not sinned, let him be the first to throw a stone at her"* - It makes us examine ourselves and stop throwing judgements on others.

"See, I am doing something new." God declares that something new is happening. It is the Divine Mercy. It transforms the life of a believer and makes us new creatures. We are restored to an everlasting relationship with our merciful, loving God and our fellow beings.

By saying *"If there is one of you who has not sinned, let him be the first to throw a stone at her."* Jesus gives the Scribes and pharisees an opportunity and time to examine themselves and return to the Lord. But their self-righteous attitude makes them to depart from the spot, beginning with the eldest.

Let's look at that woman at Jesus' feet. She was sinful. She should have been killed for her sins, at least according to the law of her time. Jesus raises her up from the dungeon of sin by saying *"neither do I condemn you, go away, and sin no more."* Jesus loves the sinner and hates sin.

We are a week away from the celebration of the passion and death and resurrection of Jesus. Let us make a plan to receive the Mercy of God through the sacrament of Reconciliation

The Christian does not throw stones. The Christian bathes people with mercy.
