GOSPEL:

Luke 14:1.7-14 On a Sabbath day Jesus had gone for a meal to the house of

one of the leading Pharisees; and they watched Him closely. He then told the guests a parable, because He had noticed how they picked the places of honour. He said this, 'When someone invites you to a wedding feast, do not take your seat in the place of honour. A more distinguished person than you may have been invited, and the person who invited you both may come and say, "Give up your place to this man." And then, to your embarrassment, you would have to go and take the lowest place. No; when you are a guest, make your way to the lowest place and sit there, so that, when your host comes, he may say, "My friend, move up higher." In that way, everyone with you at the table will see you honoured. For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled but the man who humbles himself will be exalted.' Then He said to his host, 'When you give a lunch or a dinner, do not ask your friends, brothers, relations or rich neighbours, for fear they repay your courtesy by inviting you in return. No; when you have a party, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind; that they cannot pay you back means that you are fortunate, because repayment will be made to you when the virtuous rise again.'

THE SUNDAY OBLIGATION

Extract from a Pastoral Letter to the Catholic People of the Archdiocese of Perth, Tuesday, 16 August 2022

This is, of course, one of the principle reasons for the long-standing tradition in Catholicism of insisting on "the Sunday Obligation". You will be aware that, with the advent of the COVID-19 pandemic, I temporarily suspended this obligation in order to protect vulnerable people from this disease and to free them from any conscientious scruples they might have had in relation to this matter. I believe that the time has come to remind us all again of the centrality of the Eucharist and of our need for the Eucharist. For that reason, I am reinstating the Sunday obligation, effective from the first Sunday in September (Sunday, 4 September 2022)
