FIRST READING: *Wisdom 11:22-12:2*

In your sight, Lord, the whole world is like a grain of dust that tips the scales, like a drop of morning dew falling on the ground. Yet you are merciful to all, because you can do all things and you overlook men's sins so that they can repent. GOSPEL: *Luke 19:1-10*

He was anxious to see what kind of man Jesus was, but he was too short and could not see for the crowd; so he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore tree to catch a glimpse of Jesus who was to pass that way. When Jesus reached the spot, He looked up and spoke to him, 'Zacchaeus, come down. Hurry because I must stay at your house today.' And he hurried down and welcomed Him joyfully. They all complained when they saw what was happening. 'He has gone to stay at a sinner's house,' they said. But Zacchaeus stood his ground and said to the Lord, 'Look, Sir, I am going to give half my property to the poor and if I have cheated anybody I will pay him back four times the amount.'
