## THE HUMAN FAMILY IS AN IMAGE OF THE TRINITY

The Catechism of the Catholic Church gives us an analogy wherein we can see the reasonableness of the Trinity by helping us to see the possibility of distinct persons who possess the same nature. CCC 2205 provides:

***"The Christian family is a communion of persons, a sign and image of the communion of the Father and the Son in the Holy Spirit."*** When we think of a family, we can see how a father, mother, and child can be distinct persons and yet possess the same nature (human), just as the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are three distinct persons who each possess the same nature (divine).

The weakness, of course, is that in God each person possesses the one infinite and immutable divine nature, and is therefore, one being. Our analogous family consists of three beings. No analogy is perfect.
