GOSPEL:

Mark 10:17-30

Jesus was setting out on a journey when a man ran up, knelt before Him and put this question to Him, 'Good Master, what must I do to inherit eternal life?' You know the commandments: You must not kill; You must not commit adultery; You must not steal; You must not bring false witness; You must not defraud; Honour your father and mother.'
