right hand and the other at your left in your glory.' 'You

replied, 'We can.' Jesus said to them, 'The cup that I  
must drink you shall drink, and with the baptism with  
which I must be baptised you shall be baptised, but as

to grant; they belong to those to whom they have been  
allotted.'

The Australian Catholic Bishops Conference has broadened the scope of safeguarding of children to include adults at risk. This induction provides an overview of the: -



- Catholic Safeguarding Standards, Policies and Procedures.
- Understanding Abuse, Grooming and Prevention.
- Reporting of concerns.
- Role of the Safeguarding Officer.
- Collective Responsibility and Care.
